## What Are Land Records?

• Land records, property ownership records, often are the only records in which you will find your ancestors mentioned in some areas.

DEEDS

- Land transactions were carefully recorded and preserved due to the importance of proving one's ownership of land. Even when a courthouse was burned or was flooded, attempts were made to recreate records.
- Sometimes they can even be used to locate an ancestor's farm or original house, so that we can walk today where our family walked long ago.

The most essential land record is the deed. Deeds document the transfer or sale of title, or ownership, of a piece of land or other property from one party to another.

They sometimes contain explicit, direct statements of relationship between family members. They also may contain a will, chattel, and enslaved persons.

Many free adult males living in the US before the mid-1800s owned land. Deeds help locate a family in a particular time and place. They usually pre-date vital records and may pre-date census and church records in some areas.



When the government sold property to an individual or a group of individuals, the purchaser received a land grant. An application to purchase the land, which may include biographical information, was filed at a land office or by a government official. A warrant was then issued which authorized the purchaser to receive the land and have it surveyed. A surveyor produced a survey of the land, which consisted of a legal description of the property including its boundaries. The purchaser's name and the location of the property were recorded in a tract book at a land office or by a government official. The final document created during this process was a patent (also called a grant or first-title deed), which was issued to the new owner. The owner retained the patent, and the remaining documents were kept in case files and stored at the National Archives for federal-land sales or at state archives for state-land sales.

- Other land records that might prove essential in solving genealogy puzzles are mortgages, which in some states were recorded locally earlier than deeds.
- A mortgage is a promise by a borrower to repay a loan using real estate as collateral-in effect deeding title to the real estate to the creditor if the loan is not repaid. A similar instrument called a deed of trust, or trust deed, performs the same function with the exception that a third-party trustee takes title if the loan is not paid back in full.
- In the early years, mortgages and trust deeds were usually contracted with private individuals, but as the banking industry grew in the United States over the course of the nineteenth century, they began to be taken out with banks instead of private persons.
- Old mortgages and trust deeds are some of the most underused land records in existence-yet they can sometimes be the key that unlocks the door to that next ancestor.

One other land record that could crack the case is land tax records. Everyone who owned land had to pay taxes on it, at least in theory. Sometimes, land tax books include notations about one person inheriting land from another, or more commonly, the change in owner's name from one year to the next can indicate inheritance of the land. The absence of a deed or will showing the transfer might be explained by checking the land tax books.



Search the Catalog in Family Search Search Card Catalog or by collection in Ancestry.com

Start broad and then refine your search. (State, then county, then record type).

FamilySearch has a camera icon if the record can be viewed online.

### How do I search the FamilySearch Catalog for records?

Taken from Article Id: 1125 (FamilySearch)

The FamilySearch Catalog is a guide to many kinds of records that contain genealogical information. Records can be searchable online, or using physical materials at the FamilySearch Library.

#### Steps (website)

- 1. Sign in to FamilySearch.
- 2. In the menu banner at the top of the screen, click **Search**.
- 3. In the drop-down menu, click **Catalog**.
- 4. Narrow your search. You can use as many filters as you want.

**Place:** As you type, the system shows possible matches. Click the one that matches the place of interest.

- If you do not see any search results for the city you are looking for, add more information. The system needs enough information to be able to isolate a place geographically. A city name, however unique, is not enough information. Adding a county or province is often enough information that the system can isolate the place. City and country can work if the country only has one city with the name.
  - **Camera icon:** Browse a digitized film.
  - **Camera icon with key:** Browse a digitized film, but viewing restrictions apply.
  - Film reel icon: The digital images are not available online. A microfilm version exists.
